Keith did confirm there had been contact with a boring company. The CEO is responsible for enforcement but has stated that he has been very busy. This clearly has slipped thru the cracks, so measures need to be put in place for the future.

Possibly contact the realtors to make them aware that the pumps should not be hooked up without proper permitting. Door-by-door smoke testing would be the best detection. Airport project is stalled until April. The thaw will be hard on the road. We are at 115" total snowfall for the year, which is below historic averages of 122" to 132".
